8. DISCLAIMER in case of Damage. The greatest care possible will be taken of all exhibits, but the Executive Committee wishes to state that they cannot accept responsibility for the loss of, or damage to exhibits, no matter how they are caused.

9. ONLY 2010 MEMBERS CAN EXHIBIT. Subscriptions of £25 are overdue for the current session (2010) which commenced April 2010. **We will not accept Membership fees at the handing in session.** Members are reminded that this income is used for the financial running of the Club and prompt payment is vital. **Current 2010 Membership Number (on your BLUE Membership card or receipt) must be marked on the Entry Form.** Desk Staff will have a list of 2010 members and your Entry forms arranged alphabetically by name. If you no longer wish to be a Member, it helps administration and saves postage costs if the Secretary is informed of this in writing.(address below.)
